

10 Gigabit Ethernet Optical Module Speed

Overview of 10G Optical Modules

10 Gigabit Ethernet (10GbE) modules, commonly implemented as SFP+ transceivers, transmit data at a line rate of 10 Gbps over either multimode or single-mode fiber . These modules are hot-pluggable and designed for high-density network environments, including data centers, enterprise backbones, and metro networks .

Common 10G Module Types and Speeds

- o 10GBASE-SR (Short Reach): Operates over multimode fiber (MMF) at 850 nm wavelength, supporting distances up to 300-400 meters on OM3/OM4 fiber . Ideal for intra-rack or short data hall connections.
- o 10GBASE-LR (Long Reach): Uses single-mode fiber (SMF) at 1310 nm wavelength, supporting distances up to 10 km . Commonly deployed for campus backbones and inter-building links.
- o 10GBASE-ER (Extended Reach): Operates over single-mode fiber at 1550 nm wavelength, supporting distances up to 40 km . Suitable for metro Ethernet and long-haul interconnects.
- o 10GBASE-T: Copper-based SFP+ modules supporting 10 Gbps over CAT6a/CAT7 cables up to 30 meters .

Key Features

- o Hot-swappable: Can be installed or replaced without powering down the switch .
- o Digital Optical Monitoring (DOM): Provides real-time diagnostics for optical power, temperature, and signal quality .
- o Interoperability: Compatible with IEEE 802.3ae standards and multi-source agreements (MSAs), ensuring broad compatibility across vendors .

Practical Considerations

- o Fiber type: Multimode fiber is cost-effective for short distances, while single-mode fiber is required for longer links.
- o Wavelength selection: 850 nm for SR, 1310 nm for LR, and 1550 nm for ER modules, affecting attenuation and reach .
- o Deployment: Choose module type based on distance, fiber availability, and network architecture. For example, SFP-10G-ER is ideal for 40 km single-mode links, while SFP-10G-SR is sufficient for intra-rack connections . In summary, all 10G optical modules operate at 10 Gbps, but the maximum distance and fiber

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type vary depending on the module standard, with SR for short multimode links, LR for 10 km single-mode, and ER for extended 40 km single-mode deployments .
