

25 square meter distribution box configuration

- o Wiring: Maintain neat cable management, proper insulation, and secure grounding. Ensure wire gauge matches the load requirements .
- o Standards Compliance: Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards) and use UL/CE-certified components .
- o Documentation: Label all circuits clearly and maintain a wiring diagram for future maintenance or upgrades .
