



Access switch management is inaccessible

Preview

This issue happens because IP routing is enabled, so the switch is ignoring the ip default-gateway and has no default route, which breaks management access from other VLANs. Those switches are purely Layer 2 only. The odd thing. Recently on a layer 2 distribution switch I became unable to access the SSH or the web GUI. I can ping the problem switch from inside the VLAN, however when I attempt to ping. Is the STP like RSTP or MRSTP enabled on all switches to prevent potential loops? Does backup storage have more than 1 connection? and Additionally, it would help if you could post, and sanitized from company/private info, a PVID, port mode (access/hybrid/trunk), and untagged and tagged VLANs for. Summary: Administrators may report being unable to access PowerVault Manager, unable to open an SSH session, or log in to a serial session. Management Controller (MC) and Storage Controller (SC) are separate subsystems on ME series arrays. If the switch doesn't respond, there may be a network issue or incorrect IP.
