Optical cable length limits depend on the interface and fiber type: keep consumer TOSLINK/SPDIF under about 15 m for reliable audio. Some cables reach ~30 m but risk dropouts. Treat ADAT/Lightpipe conservatively unless your gear specifies longer spans. Use multimode fiber for short-to-medium runs. All the cables I see on Amazon are 1m or 2m etc but for my setup, 1m is too short, but 2m is a foot or so too long, and I'm not sure the best way to deal with the extra length? Thanks! Buy a \$5k fiber terminator tool so you can make custom length ?? Coil the excess into a loop no smaller than 4-5.
