- o Hot-dip galvanization: Steel is immersed in molten zinc at around 450°C, forming a metallurgical bond between the steel and zinc. This creates a thick, durable, and abrasion-resistant coating .
- o Pre-galvanized (Sendzimir) steel: Steel sheets are coated with zinc before forming into trays, providing uniform corrosion protection across welds and corners .
- o Electro-galvanized steel: A thinner zinc layer is applied via electroplating, suitable for indoor environments with low corrosion risk .
