Flexible raceways or E-chains can accommodate moving equipment, such as sit-stand consoles, without straining cables . **Grommets and Sleeves:** Use grommets at openings to protect cables from sharp edges and to maintain a clean, sealed environment .

Best Practices

- o **Plan Layout Before Installation:** Map out equipment placement, cable routes, and cabinet organization based on network topology and user requirements .
- o **Bundle and Secure Cables:** Use Velcro ties instead of plastic zip ties to avoid overtightening and allow easy adjustments .
- o **Maintain Accessibility:** Ensure cables are easy to trace and replace without disturbing other connections. Reverse cable management, routing cables from patch panels outward, can improve maintenance access .
- o **Accommodate Future Growth:** Design CMS with flexibility for moves, additions, and changes (MACs) to support future expansion .
