Cable Terminal Boxes and Cable Termination Heads are essential components for safely terminating and connecting medium and high voltage cables, providing insulation, mechanical protection, and secure electrical connections.

Cable Terminal Box

A Cable Terminal Box is an enclosure designed to house the end of a medium or high voltage cable, protecting the termination from environmental factors and ensuring safe electrical connections. These boxes are used for voltages typically ranging from 11kV to 33kV, and sometimes higher. Key features include:

- o Insulation: Terminal boxes can be filled with transformer oil, insulating compounds (like G101), or Guroflex to provide excellent electrical insulation.
- o Types:
 - o Air Partially Insulated Cable Box: Requires no additional site insulation.
 - o Heat Shrink Cable Termination Box: Uses heat shrink tubing for full insulation.
 - o Plug-In Connector Cable Box: Fully insulated with plug-in bushings for separable connectors.
- o Protection: They safeguard cable ends from moisture, dust, and mechanical damage, and facilitate safe connections to switchgear, transformers, or overhead lines.
- o Customization: Boxes can be supplied with pre-fitted glands or pilot holes for easy installation.

Cable Termination Head

A Cable Termination Head (or cable termination kit) is used to terminate the end of a cable, providing a secure electrical connection and insulation for the exposed conductors. These are typically used in medium voltage (12-42 kV) and high voltage applications. Key aspects include:

- o Construction: Often made from EPDM rubber, epoxy, or cold/heat-shrinkable materials to ensure long-term reliability under harsh conditions.
- o Function: Provides electrical insulation, mechanical support, and environmental protection for the cable end.
- o Standards Compliance: Termination heads comply with international standards such as IEC 60502-4, EN 50393, and may have ATEX/IECEx approvals for hazardous locations.
- o Design Variants: Can be indoor or outdoor, with options for single or multiple cable entries, and may include IP68-rated enclosures for water and dust protection.
