Key Principles of Cable Arrangement

Separation of Electrical and Instrumentation Cables: Power cables should be positioned above instrumentation or control cables to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI). Layered separation is recommended, with high-current or high-voltage cables kept apart from low-voltage signal cables to preserve signal integrity .

Spacing and Segregation: Maintain a minimum vertical and horizontal distance between power and control trays, typically at least 300mm (12 inches). Where space is limited, metal partitions can prevent interference .

Phase Sequence and Parallel Cables: When multiple cables are used in parallel for the same phase, correct phase sequencing and arrangement are critical. Improper arrangement can cause imbalanced currents, overheating, and insulation damage. Ensuring uniform current distribution through proper cable layout mitigates these risks .

Tray Layout and Routing

Optimal Path Planning: Cable trays should follow the shortest practical route, avoiding unnecessary bends and crossovers. Multi-level layouts or bridges can prevent physical interference between trays .

Bend Radius and Overcrowding: Adhere to the recommended bend radius for each cable type to prevent stress and signal loss. Avoid overcrowding trays to reduce heat buildup and mechanical damage .

Support and Mounting: Use appropriate brackets, clamps, and supports to prevent sagging. Supports are typically spaced 1.5 to 3 meters apart depending on tray type and load .

Environmental and Safety Considerations

Heat Dissipation: Allow air gaps between trays for ventilation, especially for high-voltage or high-current cables. Overheating can shorten cable lifespan .

Material Selection: In humid or corrosive environments, use stainless steel or coated aluminum trays. Fire-retardant trays or coatings are recommended in hazardous zones .

Grounding and Bonding: Metal trays must be properly grounded to ensure safety and compliance with electrical standards .
