Material Selection and Suitability

All trays and accessories, including bends, tees, reducers, covers, supports, and hangers, must be inspected for damage, coating quality, and compliance with approved submittals before installation.

Site Preparation and Inspection

- o **Verify Materials:** Check all received trays and accessories against approved material submittals and raise a Material Inspection Request (MIR) for employer approval.
- o **Storage:** Store trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports at intervals of one meter, protected from moisture and direct sunlight.
- o **Area Preparation:** Ensure installation areas are clean, free of obstructions, and have safe access for personnel and equipment.

Installation Methodology

- o **Review Shop Drawings:** Confirm tray routes, lengths, and locations, ensuring horizontal and vertical runs only, with adequate clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance.
- o **Mounting and Supports:** Install hangers, brackets, and supports according to manufacturer instructions and project specifications. Maintain proper alignment and level throughout the installation.
- o **Securing Trays:** Use approved bolts and fasteners, ensuring trays are free from dirt, oil, or corrosion before securing. Avoid bending or damaging coatings during installation.
- o **Supervision:** Installation should be supervised by a competent electrical engineer or qualified personnel to ensure compliance with safety and quality standards.

Safety Considerations

- o **Lighting:** Provide adequate task and emergency lighting to ensure safe working conditions.
- o **Emergency Procedures:** Follow site-specific emergency arrangements, including communication protocols and assembly points.
