Level 3 Distribution Boxes typically use copper busbars with insulated phase conductors, heavy-duty cable glands, and phase-colored insulation for low-voltage distribution.

Cable Type and Conductor

For Level 3 LT Distribution Boxes, copper conductors are preferred due to their high conductivity and reliability. Busbars inside the box are usually made of copper flat strips, e.g., 25x4 mm for smaller capacities, with heat-shrinkable or phase-colored insulation (Red, Yellow, Blue, Black) to ensure proper phase identification and safety (). Flexible rubber cables such as H07RN-F can be used for incoming and outgoing feeders, offering mechanical strength, flexibility, and resistance to water, chemicals, and UV exposure ().

Voltage Rating and Insulation

The cables should be rated for low-voltage applications up to 1 kV, suitable for LT distribution. Insulation must comply with standards such as IEC 60228 for conductor class and EN 50363 for thermosetting rubber insulation. Heat-shrinkable tubing or phase-colored paint ensures proper insulation between phases ().

Cable Glands and Termination

Heavy-duty, double compression brass cable glands are recommended for both incoming and outgoing cables. These glands provide secure mechanical and electrical connections while preventing water ingress. Detachable plates are often provided for fixing cable glands at the bottom of the box ().
