

Can a distribution box be connected to a surge wire

Key Considerations for Connection

Surge Protection Device (SPD) Placement: SPDs should be installed as close as possible to the main power supply point or distribution box to minimize voltage drop and residual voltage during surges . For residential systems, this is typically at the mains infeed or the bottom connection area of the meter cabinet . **Grounding Requirements:** The SPD's earth-connection terminal must be connected to the distribution box's dedicated surge protection grounding terminal, not the general protective earth (PE) of the system . For type I arresters, both earth terminals should be connected: one to the building's equipotential bonding and the other to the PE conductor . The grounding wire should be as short as possible and have a large cross-section to reduce inductive voltage drop . **Wiring Geometry:** A T-shaped connection is commonly used, where a cable branches off from the main circuit to the SPD . The connecting wires should be short, thick, and preferably stranded to reduce self-inductance and improve SPD performance . Excessively long wires can increase the effective voltage at the protected equipment, reducing the SPD's effectiveness . **Connection to Circuit Breakers:** SPDs should be connected through an appropriately rated circuit breaker or fused disconnect switch, rather than directly into the main lugs of the panel, to allow safe servicing and overcurrent protection . **Distance and Standards Compliance:** The maximum cable length between the SPD and the distribution box should generally not exceed 0.5-10 meters depending on the SPD type and installation standard (VDE 0100-534, IEC 60364-4-443), . If the distance is longer, additional SPDs may be required closer to sensitive devices.

- o Short, thick, and low-inductance wiring
 - o Proper grounding to the dedicated SPD terminal
 - o Installation close to the power supply or distribution box
