

Can a dual-fiber optical module be used with a single-fiber optical fiber

Short answer: Usually yes, you use them in pairs, but the "pair" can be a media converter on one end and a fiber switch (or SFP in a switch) on the other, as long as both sides speak the same speed, wavelength, and optical mode. A single fiber optical transceiver, known as Bidi transceiver, allows bidirectional communication over a single optical fiber. This design uses two different wavelengths for transmitting and receiving signals. BIDI module only has 1 port, wave filtering through the filter of module, and finished the transmitting of 1310nm optical signal. Dual fiber uses the same wavelength on two fiber strands; one for transmit, and one for receive.
