

# Can a flexible grounding connection be used for a distribution box

## Key Components

**Flexible Braided Straps:** Braided copper or tinned copper straps are ideal for connecting the distribution box body, door, and internal components. They provide flexibility to accommodate movement, thermal expansion, and vibration while maintaining a continuous conductive path . Straps can be supplied with or without insulation and in flat or wire-rope profiles, depending on space and current requirements .

**Grounding Busbars:** A grounding busbar serves as a central point to collect and distribute grounding from incoming feeders to outgoing circuits. Copper, brass, or aluminum busbars are commonly used, and they allow multiple connections with minimal maintenance . Busbars are particularly effective in high-current applications and reduce the need for multiple long grounding wires.

## Installation Practices

**Connection Points:** Attach grounding straps to dedicated terminals or welded bolts inside the box. For stainless steel enclosures, ensure the contact surfaces are clean and free of oxide layers. Use serrated or anti-loosening washers to maintain low contact resistance over time .

**Flexible Door Connections:** Connect the door panel to the box body using braided copper tape to maintain grounding continuity when the door is opened or closed .

**Wire Sizing and Resistance:** Follow local standards for wire sizing. For example, in the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm<sup>2</sup>) ground wire is typical, while other markets may require 6 mm<sup>2</sup>. Ensure the total ground resistance between system parts is below 0.1 Ohm . For long tool cables or multiple spindles, consider parallel grounding wires to reduce total resistance .

**Corrosion Protection:** Apply a small amount of conductive grease at stainless steel connections to prevent electrochemical corrosion and maintain low resistance over time .
