

Can an OM3 fiber optic test cable be used to test an OM4 fiber optic cable

If you're testing an OM4 cable plant, you don't need to worry about the fact that the Test Reference Cords (TRCs) that come with Fluke Networks CertiFiber(R) Pro are made with OM3 fiber. In our last Cable Testing 101 series, we covered the difference between OM3 and OM4 50um multimode fiber -- primarily the fact that the fiber core of OM4 has been constructed to provide better attenuation and higher bandwidth, thereby allowing for longer link lengths. With OM4 at a premium over OM3 fiber is a type of laser-optimized multimode fiber (MMF) designed for high-speed data transmission in enterprise networks and data centers. It belongs to the ISO/IEC multimode fiber classification system and uses a 50/125 um core/cladding structure, which enables it to transmit optical signals. OM3 is most commonly used for 10G connections because it can support them for up to 300 meters. OM4 is considered an upgrade to OM3, but there are some important characteristics to cover.

When comparing fiber optic cable OM3 vs. OM4, the most important technical differences relate to modal bandwidth, supported Ethernet speeds, and maximum transmission distance.
