

Can the panel of the fiber optic splice box be removed

Preview

The splice cassette is removable in order to assemble fiber optics with a splice unit. Since modern splice cassettes already contain a splice tray, a splice holder, couplings and pigtails, the installation of the cables. For additional access to splice area remove front and rear panels. To remove front (top) access panel loosen side thumb screws and pull panel forward (Fig. There are hundreds of different designs and options on splice closures.

Arranging fibers inside splice trays may require twisting the fiber but following the closure manufacturer's instructions will minimize the stress on the fiber.
