

Can the router be connected directly to the fiber optic cable

How Fiber Optic Connections Work

- o Router: A standard or fiber-ready router with a WAN or SFP port to receive the Ethernet signal from the ONT .
- o Ethernet Cable (Cat5e or higher): Connects the ONT to the router's WAN port to maintain high-speed data transfer .

Step-by-Step Connection

- o Locate the Fiber Outlet: This is where the ISP's fiber line enters your home.
- o Connect Fiber to ONT: Carefully insert the fiber optic cable into the ONT's designated port, ensuring the connector is clean and properly seated .
- o Power On the ONT: Wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating the optical signal is successfully converted .
- o Connect ONT to Router: Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port .
- o Power On the Router: Confirm the router's indicator lights show a successful connection. You can then configure Wi-Fi and network settings as needed .

- o Handle fiber connectors carefully; dirt or misalignment can degrade signal quality by over 30% .
