China Mobile International (CMI) has officially launched the PEACE submarine cable, a 15,000-kilometre undersea link that connects Singapore and France, extending its reach to Malaysia and various European countries. State-owned telecom firms in China are developing a \$500 million undersea fiber-optic internet cable network to compete with a similar US-backed project, according to four people involved in the deal.
