Optical cable fittings can be categorized by fiber type, connector design, polish style, and fiber count, covering single-mode, multimode, and multi-fiber applications.

1. By Fiber Type

- o Single-Mode Connectors: Designed for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications with a core diameter of 8-10 μm . Common connectors include LC, SC, FC, and MU, often with PC, UPC, or APC polish .
- o Multimode Connectors: Used for shorter distances, typically in buildings, with core diameters of 50 or 62.5 μm . Popular types are ST, MTRJ, LC, and SC, usually with PC or UPC polish .

2. By Connector Design

- o LC (Lucent Connector): Small form factor (1.25 mm ferrule), ideal for high-density panels, duplex or uniboot versions, supports both single-mode and multimode fibers .
- o SC (Subscriber Connector): Square shape, push-pull coupling, widely used in FTTH and data centers, available in SC/UPC and SC/APC .
- o ST (Straight Tip): Bayonet-style lock, common in legacy LANs and campus networks, mainly multimode .
- o FC (Ferrule Connector): Threaded coupling, suitable for high-vibration environments, often single-mode with APC polish .
- o MTRJ (Mechanical Transfer Registered Jack): Duplex multimode connector, compact design for building networks .
- o MPO/MTP (Multi-Fiber Push-On): Multi-fiber connectors (12, 24, 36 fibers), used in high-density, high-bandwidth environments, including 400G/800G applications .
- o VSFF (Very Small Form Factor): Includes CS connectors, QSFP-DD, OSFP transceiver interfaces, optimized for extreme port density .

3. By Polish Type

- o PC (Physical Contact): Standard polish for general applications, reduces back reflection .
- o UPC (Ultra Physical Contact): Low insertion loss, used in digital, CATV, and telephony systems .
- o APC (Angled Physical Contact): Angled ferrule for minimal back reflection, preferred in CATV and analog systems .

4. By Fiber Count

- o Simplex: Single fiber terminated in the connector. Examples: FC, ST, SC, LC, MU, SMA .
- o Duplex: Two fibers terminated in one connector housing. Examples: SC, LC, MU, MTRJ .

Classification of Optical Cable Fittings

- o Multi-Fiber: More than two fibers (up to 24 or more) terminated in a single connector, typically MPO/MTP .

5. By Application

- o High-Density Data Centers: LC duplex, MPO/MTP, VSFF connectors for compact, high-bandwidth setups .
- o Telecom and FTTH: SC/APC, LC, ST connectors for reliable subscriber connections .
- o Industrial or High-Vibration Environments: FC connectors with APC polish for secure, low-reflection connections .
