

Connection of galvanized pipe for cable tray

Material Compatibility and Corrosion Considerations

Galvanized cable trays and pipes are coated with zinc to protect against corrosion. When connecting galvanized pipes to cable trays, it is important to maintain the integrity of the zinc coating to prevent galvanic corrosion. Avoid using bare copper conductors directly on aluminum trays, but for galvanized steel, standard zinc-plated or tin-plated connectors are suitable for bonding and grounding purposes .

Mechanical Connection

Galvanized pipes can be attached to cable trays using brackets, clamps, or support fittings designed for structural stability. For galvanized trays, each connection plate should be secured at both ends with at least two bolts fitted with lock nuts or spring washers to ensure a rigid and stable assembly . This prevents movement under load and maintains alignment of the cable tray system.

Grounding and Bonding

Metallic cable trays, including galvanized types, must be reliably connected to the protective earth (PE) or protective neutral (PEN) conductor. For galvanized trays, jumpers between connection plates are not required, but all metallic supports, including pipes, should be bonded to the tray system to maintain electrical continuity . Grounding clamps or zinc-plated connectors can be used to bond the pipe to the tray, ensuring that any fault current is safely conducted to earth.

Installation Best Practices

- o Inspect all galvanized surfaces for damage before installation and repair any scratches to prevent corrosion .
- o Use insulated conductors where necessary, removing insulation only at bonding points to avoid electrolytic reactions .
- o Ensure that the cable tray and pipe assembly is supported according to load requirements, with proper spacing of hangers and brackets .
- o Follow local electrical codes and standards, such as NEC Article 250.96, for grounding and bonding of metallic cable trays . By following these practices, galvanized pipes can be securely and safely integrated with cable tray systems, providing both mechanical support and reliable electrical grounding.
