

Construction Site Electrical Distribution Box Specifications and Dimensions Table

Amperage and Size Ranges

Construction site distribution boxes are available in a wide range of current ratings depending on the site load:

- o Small to medium sites: 32A to 63A, suitable for light equipment and temporary power needs .
- o Larger sites or heavy machinery: 160A to 400A, often referred to as Yellow Tariff cabinets .
