- o Short-reach 400G SR8 modules for in-rack connections typically cost \$1,400-\$1,800 from reputable third-party vendors, while long-haul coherent ZR+ modules can exceed \$130,000 from OEMs .
- o Lower-speed modules (1G-10G) and copper-based UTP SFPs are more cost-effective, often used for short-distance LAN or data center connections, leveraging existing copper infrastructure to reduce deployment costs .
- o FS offers 1/2/4G SFP transceivers supporting distances from 100m to 120km over single-mode or multi-mode fiber, providing low-power, cost-efficient options for enterprise networks .

Factors Affecting Costs

- o Module Type and Transmission Distance: Longer distances and higher speeds increase costs significantly. Short-reach modules are cheaper, while long-haul or high-bandwidth modules require advanced optics and higher investment .
- o Vendor Choice: OEM modules are generally more expensive than third-party alternatives, though they may offer better compatibility and warranty coverage .
- o Infrastructure Compatibility: Copper SFPs can reduce costs by using existing cabling, avoiding fiber installation expenses .
- o Installation and Labor: Fiber optic deployment costs include cabling, connectors, and labor, which vary by region and project complexity .

Tariff and Regulatory Considerations

International tariffs and local regulations can influence the final cost of SFP modules and fiber optic equipment:

- o In Europe, tariffs for telecommunications equipment are often benchmarked against comparable competitive markets, with regulatory authorities like Bundesnetzagentur (BNetzA) approving net tariffs for services such as Local Loop Unbundling .
- o Tariff structures may vary by country, and some regions impose no one-off fees for certain services, which can indirectly affect the total cost of deploying enterprise fiber networks .
