Key Factors Affecting Price

1. **Raw Material Costs:** Copper is the primary cost driver. High-purity copper (C11000 or C10200) is commonly used for busbars due to its excellent conductivity. Prices fluctuate based on the London Metal Exchange (LME) benchmarks, which in recent years have averaged around \$8.5-\$9.2 per kilogram . 2. **Busbar Dimensions and Volume:** The cross-sectional area (width x thickness) and length directly determine material consumption. Larger or thicker busbars increase both copper usage and fabrication costs . 3. **Custom Fabrication:** Custom busbars may require cutting, bending, punching, drilling, or plating (tinning or silvering). Freight and customs duties can significantly impact imported busbar costs . 6. **Market and Policy Influences in Belarus:** The Belarusian busbar market is influenced by government subsidies for advanced electrical infrastructure, import tariffs on raw materials, and incentives for local production. These factors can reduce or increase the effective cost depending on sourcing strategy .

Estimating Custom Price

A practical formula for estimating the cost per meter of a copper busbar is: $\text{Cost per meter} = \text{Volume (m}^3\text{)} \times \text{Copper Density (kg/m}^3\text{)} \times \text{Copper Price (USD/kg)} + \text{Processing Costs}$

- o Copper density: ~8,960 kg/m³ for high-conductivity copper
- o Processing costs: Include cutting, bending, plating, and labor
- o Additional costs: Freight, import duties, and local taxes For example, a 4-meter busbar with a cross-section of 10 mm x 50 mm made from C11000 copper could cost approximately \$200-\$400 per piece, depending on plating and fabrication complexity. Bulk orders or local production in Belarus may reduce per-unit costs.

- o Request detailed quotes from local suppliers or regional manufacturers like IZAR, specifying dimensions, plating, and current requirements .

- o Consider local production to benefit from subsidies and lower import duties.
