

Dimensions and specifications of the embedded box in the distribution box

Article Overview

Embedded boxes in distribution boxes typically range from 200 x 200 x 120 mm up to 800 x 600 x 300 mm, depending on the type and number of circuits.

Typical Dimensions

Embedded distribution boxes, also known as flush-mounted DB boxes, are designed to fit within walls while housing circuit breakers, bus bars, and other electrical components. Common wall-mount embedded box sizes range approximately:

- o Small residential boxes: 200 x 200 x 120 mm
- o Medium boxes: 400 x 300 x 150 mm
- o Large boxes for commercial or industrial use: 800 x 600 x 300 mm These dimensions refer to the external enclosure, while the internal usable space is slightly smaller due to wall thickness, door returns, and mounting hardware .

Installation Considerations

- o Height from floor: The bottom edge of the embedded box should be at least 1.5 m from the ground for distribution boxes, and 1.8 m for distribution board installation panels .
- o Alignment: The box must be level and vertical, with a deviation of no more than 3 mm, and the edges should be flush with the wall surface .
- o Structural support: For boxes wider than 500 mm, concrete lintels are recommended above the box; for widths over 300 mm, reinforced brick lintels should be used to prevent pressure damage .
- o Wall embedding: The surrounding space should be filled with cement mortar, and anti-corrosion paint should be applied to parts in contact with the wall .

Additional Notes

- o Knock-out holes: Embedded boxes come with pre-punched knock-out holes that can be removed according to wiring needs .
- o Material: Most embedded boxes are made from thermoplastics (PC, ASA) or epoxy/powder-coated steel, providing durability and electrical safety .
- o Types: Flush-mounted embedded boxes are common in modern homes and offices, while smart DB boxes may include energy monitoring and communication modules . By following these dimensions and installation guidelines, the embedded box will provide a secure, level, and accessible housing for electrical components while maintaining wall integrity and safety.
