2 Do horizontal and vertical trays need to be different sizes? Cable trays vary in size in order to accommodate varying numbers of wires. International projects are most often made in widths of between 50mm and 900mm and depths of between 50mm and 150mm. In practice, cable tray dimensions are a system of interrelated measurements --width, depth, length, and material thickness--that directly affect cable fill compliance, heat dissipation, structural loading, and long-term expandability.
