

# Dimensions of the opening for the rubber ring in the distribution box

## Article Overview

Rubber ring openings in distribution boxes typically accommodate inner diameters from 6 mm to 25 mm, with heights ranging from 10 mm to 30 mm, designed for secure sealing and cable protection.

## Standard Rubber Ring/Grommet Sizes

Rubber rings or grommets used in distribution boxes are generally made from high-elasticity NBR rubber with a Shore A hardness of 70 $\pm$ 5, providing resistance to oil, heat, and UV exposure, suitable for temperatures from -30°C to +120°C. Standard inner diameters range from 6 mm to 25 mm, while heights vary between 10 mm and 30 mm, ensuring compatibility with various cable gauges and maintaining IP67-level dust and water sealing. The flared base design enhances sealing integrity and pull-out resistance, tested to withstand over 50N of tensile force.

## Design Considerations

- o Tower or elevated design: Many protective rubber rings feature a tower-shaped structure to prevent abrasion, vibration damage, and moisture ingress at high-stress cable entry points.
- o Material selection: Nitrile butadiene rubber (NBR) is preferred for durability, chemical resistance, and long-term outdoor use.
- o Customization: Inner diameter, height, color, and hardness can be tailored to specific distribution box models or cable requirements.

## Distribution Box Integration

Distribution boxes, such as TOP-TS, TOP-TF, and TOP-LS types, provide pre-punched or knock-out openings for cable entry. The rubber ring is inserted into these openings to form a tight seal, preventing dust, water, and mechanical stress on the cables. The opening dimensions must match the grommet's inner diameter to ensure proper compression and sealing. Typical tolerances for openings are  $\pm$ 10% over the nominal grommet size.

## Practical Tips

- o Measure the cable diameter and select a grommet with a slightly smaller inner diameter for a snug fit.
- o Ensure the height of the grommet matches the thickness of the distribution box wall to maintain proper sealing.
- o For outdoor or high-stress environments, choose grommets with tower or flared base designs to enhance mechanical protection and IP-rated sealing. By following these specifications, the rubber ring will provide reliable strain relief, environmental sealing, and long-term durability for cables entering the distribution box.
