Key Components and Layout

A typical distribution box (DB) includes circuit breakers, residual current circuit breakers (RCCBs), isolators, bus bars, neutral links, and sometimes transfer switches for dual power sources . The layout diagram usually shows:

- o Incoming line section: The main power supply enters through a circuit breaker or isolator. The diagram indicates the position and type of incoming breaker and the phase sequence (R, Y, B) for three-phase systems .
- o Outgoing circuits: Each outgoing line is connected to a breaker or fuse, with clear labeling for the load type (lighting, motor, or general appliances) and voltage rating (220V single-phase or 380V three-phase), .
- o Bus bars and neutral links: Shown as horizontal or vertical strips connecting multiple circuits, with proper insulation and color coding for phases and neutral .
- o Grounding points: Indicated for safety, usually connected to the metal enclosure and marked with standard symbols .

Dimensional Measurements

For accurate installation and quality control, the dimensions of the enclosure, frame, and mounting holes are critical :

- o Outer dimensions: Height, width, and depth of the box.
- o Diagonal measurements: To ensure squareness of the enclosure.
- o Hole pitch: Spacing of mounting holes for bus bars, fan mounts, and isolators.
- o Internal clearances: Space between components for safe wiring and heat dissipation.
- o Door and hinge placement: Ensures proper opening and access to internal components . Modern measurement techniques use coordinate measuring machines (CMMs) to capture 3D coordinates of all critical points, reducing human error and ensuring repeatable accuracy .

Wiring and Installation Notes

- o Incoming lines: Typically a five-wire system (three phases, neutral, and ground). Single-phase loads use one phase, neutral, and ground; three-phase loads use all three phases plus ground .
- o Component spacing: Adequate spacing between breakers, isolators, and bus bars is shown in the diagram to prevent overheating and allow maintenance.

o Mounting: Diagrams indicate wall or floor mounting points, hinge positions, and protective barriers for live parts .

How to Read the Diagram

- o Check electrical parameters: Understand voltage, current rating, and capacity.
- o Trace incoming lines: Identify the main supply and breaker configuration.
- o Follow outgoing circuits: Note each load and protection device.
- o Identify dual power switches: If present, understand automatic switching to backup power .
