

Article Overview

Distribution boxes come in various sizes with standardized hole diameters (2", 3", 4") and multiple outlet configurations, with dimensions depending on the model and material.

General Specifications

- o **Material:** Most distribution boxes are made from high-density polyethylene (HDPE) or flame-resistant ABS plastic, ensuring durability, corrosion resistance, and insulation properties .
- o **Hole Sizes:** Standard pipe entry holes are typically 2", 3", or 4" (50mm, 75mm, 110mm), compatible with twist-and-lock seals or plugs .
- o **Number of Outlets:** Boxes range from 4-hole to 10-hole configurations, with some models offering pre-cut or uncut options for flexibility .

Installation Features

- o **Risers:** Optional risers allow at-grade access and inspection, with anti-flotation adapters for stability .
- o **Busbar and Dropper Accommodation:** For electrical distribution boxes, busbars and droppers are pre-drilled and insulated with PVC sleeves, maintaining phase separation and safety .
- o **Compliance:** Boxes comply with relevant standards such as BS EN60439-3 for ABS units and local codes for HDPE boxes .

- o Pre-cut boxes simplify installation, while uncut boxes allow custom hole placement.
- o Hole spacing and layout vary by manufacturer; always refer to the specific product datasheet for exact measurements.
