- o Automatic Transfer Switch (ATS): Monitors voltage and frequency of the primary source and automatically transfers the load to the backup source when a failure is detected. It returns the load to the primary source once it is restored .
- o Static Transfer Switch (STS): Uses solid-state devices like SCRs or IGBTs to switch power sources almost instantaneously (less than 4 milliseconds), ideal for sensitive equipment such as data centers .
