

# Distribution box outgoing and incoming lines

## Incoming Lines

The incoming line is the main power supply entering the distribution box. It can be a single-line supply or dual-line supply (normal and backup) depending on the system design . The incoming line is typically connected to a main circuit breaker such as a double-pole MCB or MCCB, which protects the distribution box from overcurrent and short circuits . In systems with dual power sources, a dual power switch or automatic transfer switch ensures that the backup supply activates if the main supply fails . The incoming line is also connected to the busbars, which serve as a central point for distributing power to outgoing circuits .

## Outgoing Lines

Outgoing lines carry power from the distribution box to individual loads such as lighting, motors, pumps, or appliances . Each outgoing line is protected by a dedicated circuit breaker (MCB, RCCB, or RCBO) to prevent overloads, short circuits, and leakage currents . The outgoing lines are connected to the busbar system, which distributes the incoming power to each circuit. A neutral bar and earth bar are used to complete the circuit and ensure safety . In single-phase domestic installations, the main MCB feeds the RCCB, which then supplies the individual output MCBs, ensuring both overcurrent and leakage protection .

## Key Components Related to Lines

- o Busbars: Conductive bars that distribute incoming power to outgoing circuits.
- o MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers): Protect individual outgoing circuits from overcurrent.
- o RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers): Protect against leakage currents and electric shocks.
- o Neutral and Earth Bars: Provide return paths and grounding for safety.
- o Indicators and Meters: Monitor voltage, current, and operational status of the distribution box .
