Types and Materials

Distribution boxes are generally made from steel plates or flame-resistant ABS plastic, with insulating plates also acceptable. Wooden materials are not recommended due to safety concerns. Plastic boxes are commonly used for residential and commercial applications, while metal boxes are preferred for industrial or high-load environments.

- o Mobile boxes: Bottom should be 0.6-1.5 m above ground

- o Spacing: Distance between distribution and switch boxes should not exceed 30 m; horizontal distance to fixed equipment should not exceed 3 m

- o Safety: Each box must have its own switch and RCD (rated ≤ 30 mA, operating time ≤ 0.1 s)

- o Mechanical: Boxes must be installed straight, firmly, and locked; no temporary equipment or sundries
