Finding the Distribution Box

A home's distribution box (also called an electrical panel or breaker box) is usually found in the basement, garage, utility room, or mounted outside near the electrical meter. Look for a rectangular metal box, often gray, about the size of a medicine cabinet, positioned close to where power lines enter the home . In apartments, it may be inside the unit, often in the kitchen or bathroom area .

Inside the Distribution Box

Once you open the panel, you will see several key components:

- o Main Breaker: The largest switch, usually at the top or bottom, controls electricity to the entire building. It allows you to shut off all power during maintenance or emergencies .
- o Individual Circuit Breakers: These are smaller switches arranged in rows in the center of the panel. Each breaker protects a specific circuit, such as lighting, outlets, or appliances. They trip automatically if there is an overload or short circuit .
- o Busbars: Metal bars behind the breakers that distribute electricity from the main breaker to each individual breaker .
- o Neutral and Ground Bars: Provide safe return paths for electrical current and grounding, reducing the risk of electric shock .

Safety and Accessibility

- o Ensure at least 3 feet of clearance in front of the panel and that the door can open at least 90 degrees .
- o Keep the area around the panel clutter-free and make sure all household members know its location .
- o Only interact with breakers if you are confident and follow proper safety precautions; otherwise, contact a licensed electrician .
