

Do switch access ports need to be configured with IP addresses

Contrary to Router/Firewall configuration, Layer 2 Switch has ports configured as Layer 2 which can't be given an IP address, instead SVI (Switched Virtual Interface) needs to be assigned an IP address. Switch is assigned IP address to manage it via Telnet or. Putting both ports in the same VLAN is an excellent first step. Assigning a static IP to the server is quite appropriate. Where the IP address needs to be assigned is to the PC. Cisco switches generally don't have IP addresses assigned to Layer 2 access ports. A Layer 3 port doing routing would have an IP address assigned to it. If one device is connected to the port it is usually an access port with no IP address so the security panel most likely is assigned the IP. A switch by default doesn't need an IP address to forward the frame between ports as its default configuration setting is that way that makes a Cisco Switch a plug-n-play device. There is VLAN 1 already configured and all the physical ports are in VLAN 1. But if they don't, they must connect wirelessly to something.
