Most fiber optic cable installations are designed around controlled pulling. Pushing fiber cable through a pathway can cause buckling, kinking or jacket damage, especially in longer runs. Installation methods for both wire and optical fiber communications cables are similar. Fiber cable is designed to be pulled with much greater force than copper wire if pulled correctly, but excess stress on the cable may harm the fibers, potentially causing eventual failure.
