

Does the access switch need to be configured with VLAN IP

Preview

Here, there is no need to assign VLAN to the ports as all the switch ports on both switches are configured as VLAN 1 by default. Access ports are used to connect end devices, such as PCs, printers, and servers, to the switch. If we do not configure VLAN for a port in 'access' mode the interface will carry traffic for default VLAN (VLAN 1). This isolates traffic within each VLAN, enhancing security and reducing broadcast traffic. VLANs improve network management and require routing for inter-VLAN communication. Before you create VLANs, you must decide whether to use VLAN Trunking Protocol (VTP) to maintain global VLAN configuration for your network.

The switchport access VLAN is a command which assigns layer 2 interface on a Cisco switch to specific VLAN. This

If you plan to configure many VLANs on the device and to not enable routing, you can set the Switch Database

The voice VLAN is configured using the switchport voice vlan vlan-id interface configuration mode command. Referring to the

VLANs can be configured on VLAN capable devices through management interfaces like Web User Interface (Web UI), Command

Switch ports can be set either in trunk or access mode to have more control on switch port behaviour. Using switchport

When configuring an access port, you also want to define which VLAN the port belongs to. To configure and assign a switch access

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Access switches don't have SVIs for all VLANs - the core switch does the inter-VLAN routing. But access switches

However, to perform switch management over the network or use protocols such as SNMP, the switch will need to have an IP

To enable this, IP routing must be globally enabled on the switch, and the VLAN must be active with at least one access or trunk port

Configuring Access and Trunk Interfaces Ethernet interfaces can be configured either as access ports or trunk ports.
