- o Neutral and Earth Links: Separate bars for neutral and grounding wires, often positioned alongside the bus bars, ensuring proper grounding and safety .

Wiring Path

The wiring inside a distribution box is generally organized so that incoming wires connect to the main switch, then the bus bars carry power down the middle, and finally, branch wires connect from the bus bars to the individual MCBs or protective devices . This layout ensures a neat, safe, and efficient distribution of electricity while minimizing the risk of short circuits or overloads.
