

Does the router support fiber optic output

Most home routers do not have a direct fiber optic output; instead, they connect to a fiber network via an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) using Ethernet.

How Fiber Internet Connects to a Router

Fiber internet uses light signals transmitted through fiber optic cables, which cannot be directly processed by standard routers. Instead, a fiber internet setup typically includes an ONT, which converts the optical signals into electrical signals that your router can handle . The router then distributes the internet connection to your devices via Ethernet or Wi-Fi.

Router Requirements for Fiber

While routers themselves usually do not have fiber ports, they must support high-speed Ethernet connections to fully utilize fiber internet speeds. Many modern routers designed for fiber include:

- o 10G WAN/LAN ports for multi-gigabit speeds
 - o Gigabit Ethernet ports for standard fiber plans
 - o Wi-Fi 6 or Wi-Fi 7 for high-speed wireless distribution
- These routers are often marketed as fiber-ready or fiber-compatible, meaning they can handle the high bandwidth provided by fiber connections, but the actual fiber optic signal is terminated at the ONT, not the router itself .
