Domestic distribution boxes are sized based on the number of circuits, switch widths, and incoming wire sizes, with typical dimensions calculated to ensure safe and efficient installation.

General Size Guidelines

For residential distribution boxes, dimensions depend on the number of circuits and the size of incoming wires:

- o Lighting or small power loads (less than 10 mm² wire, fewer than 20 switches):
 - o Width: Sum of switch widths + 20 mm on each side
 - o Height: Switch height + 40 mm
 - o Depth: Maximum switch depth + 10 mm
- o More than 20 switches (same wire size):
 - o Width: Sum of switch widths + 40 mm
 - o Height: Switch height + 40 mm
 - o Depth: Maximum switch depth + 10 mm
 - o Configuration: Two rows of switches
- o Separate row for incoming line switch:
 - o Width: Sum of switch widths + 40 mm (20 mm extra on each side)
 - o Height: Switch height + 40 mm
 - o Depth: Maximum switch depth + 10 mm
- o Power distribution boxes (wire size >10 mm²):
 - o Same calculations as above, but allow extra space for bending radius of incoming wires and terminal connections .

Typical Wall-Mount Enclosure Sizes

Manufacturers often follow common size families for wall-mounted domestic DBs :

Type	Height (mm)	Width (mm)	Depth (mm)	Notes
Small (1-6 ways)	200-300	200-300	120-150	Single row, lighting circuits
Medium (6-12 ways)	300-500	300-400	150-200	Two rows, mixed circuits
Large (12-36 ways)	500-800	400-600	200-300	Multiple rows, accommodates power circuits and future expansion

- o Number of Ways: Distribution boxes range from 1-way to 36-ways, depending on household requirements .
- o Future Expansion: Add 30% extra capacity to account for future circuits .
- o IP Rating: For indoor residential use, IP20 is common; for outdoor or wet areas, higher IP ratings (IP44/67) may be required .
- o Mounting: Ensure proper wall-mounting space and clearance for cable entry and maintenance.
- o Safety: Proper sizing prevents overheating, reduces fire risk, and ensures compliance with local electrical codes .
