Distribution boxes on construction sites should be installed in dry, ventilated, and accessible locations, with proper spacing, structural support, and proximity to power sources and equipment.

Placement Guidelines

- o Proximity to Power Supply: The main distribution box should be located close to the incoming power source to minimize voltage drop and simplify connections, while secondary distribution boxes should be near concentrated electrical loads or equipment clusters ().
- o Distance Between Boxes: The distance between the main distribution box and secondary distribution boxes should not exceed 30 meters, and the horizontal distance from a switch box to the equipment it controls should be within 3 meters ().
- o Environmental Considerations: Install boxes in dry, ventilated areas away from harmful media such as gas, steam, flue gases, liquids, or heat sources. Avoid locations prone to impact, vibration, or water splashing (). Outdoor boxes should have appropriate IP or NEMA ratings (e.g., IP66 or NEMA 4X) for waterproofing and dust protection ().

Structural and Construction Requirements

- o Material: Use iron plates or high-quality insulating materials for the box, with iron plate thickness greater than 1.5 mm for durability ().
- o Mounting: Electrical equipment inside the box should be mounted on a metal or non-wood insulated plate, which is then fastened to the box. Ensure the metal plate is electrically bonded to the box for grounding ().
- o Accessibility: Leave sufficient space around the box for at least two people to work simultaneously. Avoid stacking items or placing obstacles that hinder maintenance ().

Wiring and Safety

- o Insulated Wiring: All connecting lines should be insulated, with secure joints and no exposed live parts. Separate the working neutral from the protective neutral using terminal blocks ().
- o Grounding: Metal boxes and mounting plates must be properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards ().
- o Height Considerations: For residential or temporary construction setups, boxes are typically installed around 1.5 meters above ground. Industrial or site-specific heights may vary depending on surrounding equipment and accessibility ().
