- o Ensure unobstructed sightlines from all approaches to the box.
- o Repeat signage if multiple access points exist or if visibility is limited ().



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Compliance Considerations

- o Temporary construction site signs must meet OSHA standards for electrical hazard warnings, including high-voltage alerts and restricted access notices ().
- o Signs should be SABS approved or meet local safety authority standards if required ().
