Key Manufacturing Facilities

TKF, part of TKH Group N.V., opened a new fiber optic cable production facility in Rawicz, Poland, in September 2023. This 10,000 m² plant doubles TKF's European production capacity, partially replacing output previously produced in China. The facility was constructed between March 2022 and mid-2023 and incorporates sustainable technologies such as UV LED, LED lighting, and solar power, aligning with ESG goals. It also created over 75 full-time jobs and supports the production of innovative fiber optic solutions for Europe. YOFC Poland, a subsidiary of Yangtze Optical Fibre and Cable Joint Stock Limited Company, has also expanded its production capabilities. The plant began construction in March 2021, with the first outdoor cable produced in February 2022 and full production capacity reached by October 2022. YOFC's facility focuses on both indoor and outdoor cables, meeting European and international quality standards, and continues to expand its product mix to serve the European market.
