- o Splice or replace damaged sections using appropriate tools and techniques. For multi-core cables, ensure proper alignment of MTP(R) or MPO connectors .
- o Test the repaired cable to confirm signal integrity and that attenuation levels are within acceptable limits .

Preventive Measures

- o Use plastic clamps with large surface areas to secure cables without pinching .
 - o Avoid exceeding the maximum tensile load and adhere to manufacturer-specified bend radii .
 - o Conduct regular inspections and cleaning to prevent contamination and early detection of potential faults .
