 - o Cable management trays to prevent bending and maintain fiber integrity
 - o Splice trays for fusion or mechanical splicing

 - o Applications: SC connectors are common in FTTH and GPON networks, LC connectors are ideal for high-density data centers, and MTP/MPO connectors are used for backbone or high-speed links
- Connectors are typically paired with patch cords or pigtails to link equipment, panels, or network devices, ensuring reliable signal transmission.

- o Matching connectors to panels: Ensure the connector type is compatible with the panel adapter slots.

- o Proper cable management: Use trays and guides to avoid sharp bends, which can degrade signal quality.
