Common Causes

1. **ISP Configuration or Profile Issues** Sometimes after upgrading to a higher-speed plan, the correct speed profile may not be applied on the ISP's end, limiting your connection to lower speeds even if the hardware supports 500 Mbps . 2. **Router and Modem Compatibility** Routers may fail to negotiate properly with fiber gateways if the ISP modem is not in bridge mode or if IP addressing conflicts occur. This can prevent the router from establishing a stable connection or accessing the internet . 3. **Physical Fiber Cable Problems** Fiber cables are sensitive to bends, kinks, or contamination. A tight bend radius or dirty connectors can cause signal loss, reducing speed or causing intermittent connectivity . 4. **Network Congestion and Contention** Even with fiber, shared infrastructure at the exchange can occasionally limit speeds, though this is rare. Testing with a wired Ethernet connection is recommended to rule out Wi-Fi interference .

Troubleshooting Steps

- o **Check Physical Connections** Inspect fiber cables for bends, damage, or loose connectors. Clean connectors with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol if necessary .
- o **Test Direct Connection** Connect a device directly to the ISP's fiber modem using Ethernet to verify if the speed issue persists. If speeds are normal, the router may be misconfigured .
- o **Verify Router Settings** Ensure the router is set to the correct connection type (dynamic or static IP as required by your ISP) and that there are no IP conflicts. If using a secondary router, consider placing it in DMZ mode to avoid double NAT issues .
- o **Restart and Update Devices** Reboot the modem, router, and connected devices. Check for firmware updates for your router to ensure compatibility with high-speed fiber connections .
- o **Contact Your ISP** If speeds remain below expected levels, contact your ISP to confirm that the correct speed profile is applied and that there are no local network issues .

Additional Tips

- o Use a wired Ethernet connection for accurate speed testing.
- o Avoid Wi-Fi for initial troubleshooting, as interference can reduce speeds.
- o Monitor speeds at different times to rule out temporary network congestion. By systematically checking physical connections, router configuration, and ISP settings, most 500 Mbps fiber broadband issues can be identified and resolved.
