A red LOS (Loss of Signal) light indicates that your device is not receiving an optical signal from the fiber network, signaling a disruption in connectivity.

What the Red LOS Light Means

A red LOS light on your router, ONT, or Optical Network Unit (ONU) signifies a Loss of Signal, meaning the device cannot detect the optical signal from your Internet Service Provider (ISP) or Optical Line Terminal (OLT) upstream. This usually results in a complete loss of internet connectivity until the issue is resolved .

Common Causes

- o Fiber Cable Damage: Cuts, bends, or kinks in the fiber optic cable can interrupt the signal .
- o Loose or Dirty Connectors: Improperly seated connectors or dust/contamination on SC/APC connectors can prevent signal transmission .
- o ISP or Network Outage: Maintenance or local service interruptions can cause the LOS light to turn red .
- o Faulty Device: A malfunctioning ONT, router, or transceiver may fail to detect the signal .
- o Power Issues: Fluctuations or interruptions in power supply can affect device operation .

Troubleshooting Steps

- o Check for Outages: Visit your ISP's website or social media pages to confirm if there is a known service disruption .
- o Inspect Fiber Cables: Look for visible damage, sharp bends, or loose connections. Ensure the fiber is properly seated in the SFP or ONT port .
- o Clean Connectors: Use lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to remove dust or oil from connectors .
- o Restart Devices: Power cycle your ONT or router by unplugging it for 30 seconds and then reconnecting .
- o Check Optical Power: For enterprise setups, use an Optical Power Meter to ensure the received signal is within the device's sensitivity range (typically -28 dBm for GPON Class B+ modules), .
- o Replace Faulty Components: If the LOS light persists, consider swapping transceivers or contacting your ISP for upstream issues .

When to Contact Your ISP

If the red LOS light remains after checking cables, cleaning connectors, and restarting devices, the problem is likely upstream or requires professional intervention. Provide your ISP with details about the red LOS light and any troubleshooting steps you have already performed . By following these steps, most LOS issues can be resolved quickly, restoring your fiber optic internet connection.
