- o Breakout Patch Cords: These cords contain multiple fibers, each in its own tube, bundled together under a common outer jacket. The empty tube in this context provides mechanical separation and reduces the risk of fiber damage during installation .
- o Armored Patch Cords: Some patch cords feature fibers inside a stainless-steel or reinforced tube for high durability in harsh environments. The tube may be empty or filled with protective gel to prevent microbending and physical damage .

Applications

- o LAN and Data Centers: Empty tube patch cords are used to connect devices in racks or between racks, providing flexibility and protection for high-density fiber networks .
- o FTTx Networks: In fiber-to-the-home or fiber-to-the-building deployments, empty tube designs help protect fibers during installation and maintenance .
- o Testing and Measurement: Launch cables or test cords often use empty tubes to house fibers for OTDR testing, minimizing signal loss and protecting the fiber during repeated handling .
