Can you wire 4 lights to one switch? As long as the total load or draw of amperage does not exceed the switch's capacity, this type of arrangement will operate safely.

Before 2011, the "end of the chain" switch was commonly wired using a 3- way switch wiring option. Diagrams shown on this page are simplified for clarity.
