- o Fiber optic patch cords are plugged into the ports, sometimes color-coded to indicate different signal types or network segments.
- o Labels or markings are usually present to identify each port or splitter output.
- o In some designs, innerduct conduits are visible, guiding fibers from the main cable entry to the patch panel .
