

Height of the distribution box base

The proper installation of a distribution box involves placing it at the right height to ensure safety and convenience. Ground-mounted foundations should be 50 to 100 mm above ground level. The National Electrical Code (NEC) provides comprehensive safety standards for electrical installations, including requirements for electrical panels (main service panels and subpanels or breaker box). The body of the boxes shall have sufficient reinforcement with suitable size of channels keeping a provision for fixing and conforming to general. According to the "Code for Acceptance of Construction Quality of Building Electrical Engineering" GB50303-2002, the vertical distance between the bottom surface of the fixed stainless steel enclosure IP67 and the ground should be greater than 1m.
