

# Height of the three-level electrical distribution box in the factory building

## Article Overview

The recommended mounting height for a distribution box in a factory is typically between 4.5 and 5.5 feet (1.4 to 1.7 meters) from the floor, ensuring accessibility and compliance with safety standards.

## Recommended Mounting Height

For industrial or factory settings, wall-mounted distribution boxes should be installed at a height of 4.5 to 5.5 feet (1.4-1.7 meters) from the floor. This height allows operators to access breakers and switches comfortably without excessive bending or stretching, while also protecting the box from accidental impacts or water spills. Outdoor boxes should be mounted at least 3 feet above the ground to avoid moisture and dirt exposure.

## Compliance with Electrical Codes

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC 2023), panelboards and distribution boxes must be installed in readily accessible areas with a minimum clearance of 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet (2 meters) high in front of the panel. The top of the panelboard or disconnect switch should not exceed 6 feet 7 inches (2 meters) above the floor to ensure safe operation and maintenance. The working space in front of the equipment must remain clear and unobstructed.

## Working Space and Safety Considerations

- o Front clearance: Minimum 3 feet in front of the panel to allow full access and door opening to 90°.
- o Side clearance: Minimum 30 inches from the sides of the equipment.
- o Height clearance: Minimum headroom of 6.5 feet or the height of the equipment, whichever is greater.
- o Dedicated space: From the floor to at least 6 feet above the equipment to prevent obstructions.

## Practical Tips for Multi-Level Distribution Boxes

For a three-level distribution box, ensure that the highest circuit breaker or switch is within 6 feet 7 inches (2 meters) from the floor, even if the total height of the box exceeds this limit. This ensures that all components are reachable for operation and maintenance. The box should be firmly mounted, properly grounded, and located away from wet areas or obstructions. By following these guidelines, a factory can maintain safe, accessible, and code-compliant electrical distribution systems.
