- o Install the breakers: Place each breaker in the panel according to the planned circuits.
- o Connect incoming power: Attach the main live (phase) wires to the main breaker, neutral wire to the neutral bar, and ground wire to the ground bar .
- o Wire individual circuits: Connect each circuit's live wire to its breaker, neutral to the neutral bar, and ground to the ground bar. Ensure correct wire gauge for each circuit.
- o Organize wiring: Use cable ties and proper routing to maintain neatness and prevent interference.
- o Label circuits: Clearly mark each breaker for easy identification during maintenance .

Final Checks

- o Perform visual inspection for loose connections or exposed wires.
- o Use a multimeter to verify continuity and correct voltage.
- o Ensure all breakers and protective devices are properly installed and functional.
- o Schedule regular inspections to maintain safety and reliability .
